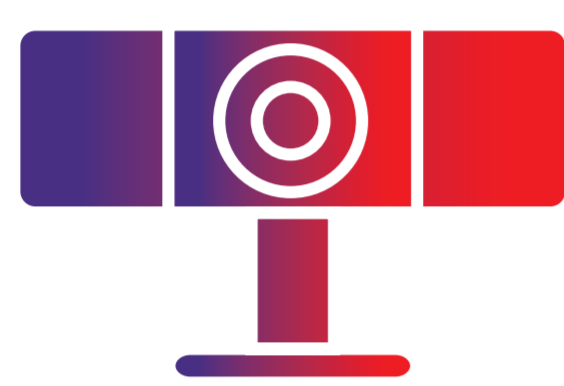

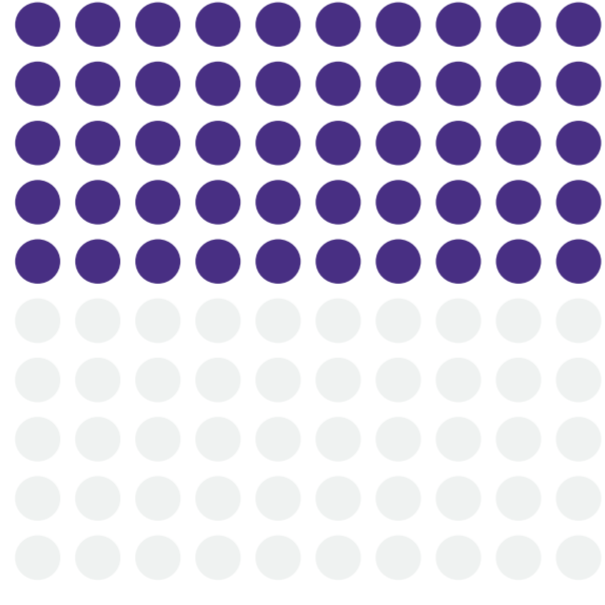
Content sharing from anywhere
